Registration is now open for the 17th annual Thames River Basin Partnership Floating Workshop. Sign in registration on the day of the event will begin at **noon** at the Roseland Park, located at 205 Roseland Park Road, in Woodstock, CT. The cost of this year's Floating Workshop is \$25, and will include a light lunch.

For our main afternoon program at Roseland Park, we will begin with a **soil health/rainfall simulator** demonstration at 1 PM, followed by a slide show summary in the barn featuring water quality issues and an overview of local conservation focused projects in the watershed beginning at 1:30 PM. Then, as the name implies, we will take to the waters of Roseland Lake at 3:30 PM to showcase some of the features discussed in the workshop. Participants must provide their own boat. Life jackets required. Extra paddle craft may be available on a first come first serve basis. A walking tour in the park will be arranged for land lubbers.

After the tour of Roseland Lake, there will be an opportunity for workshop participants to network with the conservation professionals in a casual setting to end our day.

Optional morning program: The Last Green Valley, Eastern Connecticut Conservation District and USDA Natural Resource Conservation Service will host a driving tour of completed and ongoing water quality improvement projects in the watershed beginning at 9 AM. Meet at the park by 8:30 AM to sign in if you choose this option. This event will take place rain or shine. Dress for the weather.
