Optional Camp Activities - Archery - Hiking - Paddling

Waterfront open for paddling from 3 – 5 pm: Camp Woodstock staff will open the waterfront for TLGV members to paddle around peaceful and scenic Black Pond. No need to bring your boat – Camp Woodstock will provide all the equipment including life preservers, paddles, canoes, kayaks and a few paddle boats. Enjoy at your leisure. Chief Ranger Bill Reid will provide some instruction for novice paddlers.

Hike from 3:30 – 4:30 pm: TLGV Ranger Steve Broderick will lead a nature walk in the state forest property adjacent to Camp Woodstock. Steve is a retired UConn Extension Service forester, former director of the Green Valley Institute and the Goodwin Conservation Center, and one of the most knowledgeable teachers about The Last Green Valley's forest resources.

Archery from 4 – 5 pm: Camp Woodstock staff will open the archery range for TLGV members to try their hand at this favorite camp sport. Learn something new!

5:00 – 6:00 pm: Cash Bar Social (and a few surprises) in the Lakeside Dining Lodge
