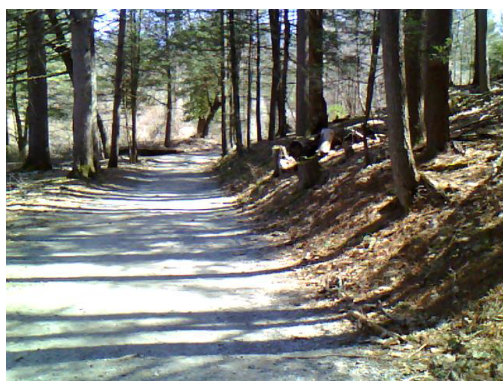

Camp Robinson Crusoe Trail to Morgan Trail

Leadmine Mountain Conservation Lands

Sturbridge, MA • Linear Trail • There are no fees for visiting the trail

Length 0.1 mi 529 ft (0.2 km)

Elev Gain 12 ft (3.66 m)

Elev Loss 2.4 ft (0.72 m)

Trail Details: 0.1 mi. GT. Trail color purple, trail starting at 10 Shattuck Rd. It is the main road into what was Camp Robinson Crusoe from the 1930 to 1970. This trail leaves the Shattuck Road trailhead and follows the old camp road downhill to the Morgan Trail and the Arbutus Park Trail. You will note foundations, stone walls, and other evidence of the camp that stood here.

Directions: From the Rt. 20 and Stallion Hill Rd. traffic light, turn onto Stallion Hill Rd., take your 2nd left (100 ft) onto Old Sturbridge Village Rd. Follow for 1 mile to Lead Mine Trail Parking Lot on the right. Trailhead is close to exit 5 on Route 84 in Sturbridge.
