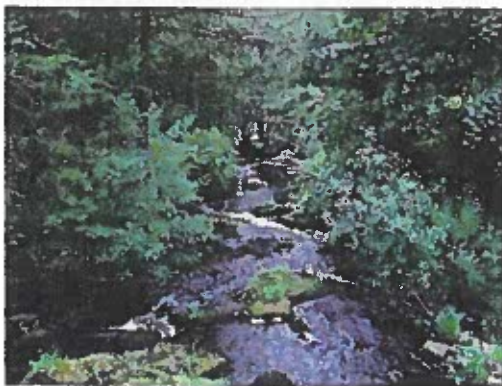
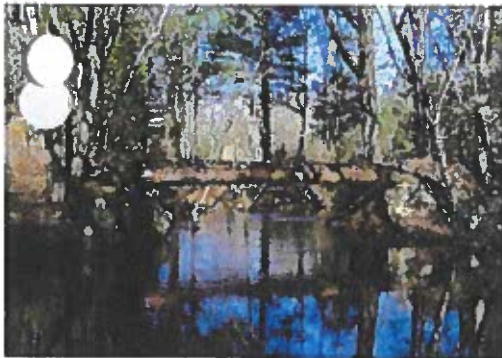

Linear Trail

There are no fees for visiting the trail

Length	0.5 mi (0.8 km)
Elev Gain	13 ft (4.0 m)
Elev Loss	4 ft (1.0 m)

Parking is available at either 25 Cat Hollow Road or Valley Road, both roads intersect with Dog Hill Road, Killingly, CT.

Cat Hollow Park Trail

1/2 mile paved walk along scenic Whetstone Brook, view ponds and dams that once provided water power for two mills. Azaleas, ground covers, trees, and other unique plantings by former owner.

4% of trail is	3% to 5%

607 ft (185 m) is	3% to 5%

OBSTRUCTIONS:

Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) or outside the area 120 in (3m) wide by 120 in (3m) high were not measured. Minimum clearance boundaries were at least 2 in (5 cm) high.

Temporary obstacles were not mapped.
