Parking There are several parking lots along Kennedy Drive.

The Putnam River Trail follows the east bank of the Quinebaug River between the river and Kennedy Drive, with views of Cargill Falls. The trail passes through the town of Putnam, known for its antique shopping, and through local parks.

Along the way interpretive displays tell about Putnam's railroad history, textile mills, the 1955 flood and the area's founding citizens.

The trail offers scenic views of the river along its route.

OBSTRUCTIONS:

Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) or outside the area 120 in (3m) wide by 120 in (3m) high were not measured. Minimum clearance boundaries were at least 2 in (5 cm) high.
