Brooklyn Riverside Park Canoe Launch

Trail Length 343 ft (0.1 km) Linear trail

Ample parking available, portable restroom at ballfield. This is a put-in and take-out location. You may paddle upstream and retuin to take out here. There is a dam with no portage downstream. Canoe/Kayak Boat Launch; Lat/Long: 41.802682, -71.896252

Typical Grade is 3.5%

24% of the trail is between 8% and 10% 83 ft (25 m) is between 8% and 10% 8% grade is a standard ramp.



Typical Cross Slope is 1.4% 100% of the trail is between 0% and 2% 0 ft (0 m) is between 3% and 2%



Typical Tread Width is 106 in (269 cm) Tread Width ranges from 106 in (269 cm) to 106 in (269 cm)



Trail Surface is Aggregate/Gravel 78% of the trail is Firm or better 75 ft (23 m) of the trail is Soft or worse
