Parking There are several parking lots along Kennedy Drive.

The Putnam River Trail extends between Arch Street in the Putnam District and Pomfret Street to the north. The trail follows the east bank of the Quinebaug River between the river and Kennedy Drive, with views of Cargill Falls. The trail passes through the town of Putnam, known for its antique shopping, and through local parks.

Along the way interpretive displays tell about Putnam's railroad history, textile mills, the 1955 flood and the area's founding citizens. One 200-foot long pedestrian bridge is built on the stone foundation of an old railroad trestle. The trail offers scenic views of the river along its route.
