## Trail Uses

**Trail Length 0.1 mi (0.2 km)**  
**Linear trail**

There is plenty of parking available, even if ball games are in progress. Park and carry your boat down the gravel driveway between the baseball fields to the paved Quinebaug River Trail. Turn left onto the trail and carry about 100 feet more to the kiosk. Watch for walkers and cyclists as this is popular trail. There are portable restrooms in the Little League complex. The put in location is down a short gravelly slope. The strong current will not allow you to return to take out here.

**Cumulative Gain 3 ft (1 m)**  
**Elevation Change Loss 14 ft (4 m)**



**Typical Grade is 3.1%**

**14% of the trail is between 8% and 18%**  
**73 ft (22 m) is between 12% and 18%**  
8% grade is a standard ramp.



**Typical Cross Slope is 2.5%**

**7% of the trail is between 5% and 9%**  
**36 ft (11 m) is between 5% and 9%**



**Typical Tread Width is 120 in (305 cm)**

**Tread Width ranges from 120 in (305 cm) to 120 in (305 cm)**  
**Minimum Clearance 44 in (112 cm)**



**Trail Surface is Aggregate/Gravel**

**100% of the trail is Firm or better**  
**0 ft (0 m) of the trail is Firm**

Obstructions less than 2.0 in (5.0 cm) or outside the tread area 120 in (3 m) wide by 120 in (3 m) high were not measured. Minimum clearance boundaries were at least 2.0 in (5.0 cm) high.
