There are about 30 free parking spaces at the West Thompson Lake boat ramp which serves power boats as well as paddle craft. You can drive down to the water to load/unload boats. Access to the water includes a broad paved boat ramp and a grassy slope into the water with sandy bottom. Portable restrooms are available from Mid-May to Columbus Day. This 200 acre lake is managed by the USACE for recreation and flood control.
