Parking & Trail Entrance

Directions to Milk Street Air Line Trail Crossing - Windham, CT

From the intersection of Main St. (Route 66) and Jackson St. in Willimantic, take Jackson St. one block north to Valley St. Ext. Turn right onto Valley St. Ext. Follow Valley St. for 470 ft. to Milk St. The Air Line Trail crossing is just south of the intersection.

Parking: Parking is available in a parking lot along the Air Line Trail between Milk St. and Jackson St.

Directions to Bridge Street (Route 32) Air Line Trail Crossing - Windham, CT

From the intersection of Main St. (Route 66), take Bridge Street (Route 32) off Main Street (Route 66) near the Windham Regional Chamber of Commerce. Just over the railroad tracks there will be an unnamed road on the right running west along the side of the railroad track. Follow unnamed road along railbed for just under 0.2 miles. You will see kiosk and parking area. **Parking:** There is parking for 17 cars including 2 handicap spots at kiosk. **DO NOT BLOCK GATES.**
