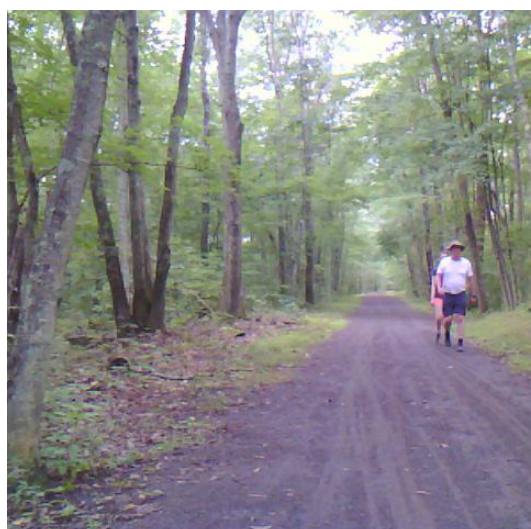

Leonard Bridge Rd. to Lebanon Rd.

Lebanon and Hebron, CT • Linear Trail

There are no fees for visiting the trail

Length	2.1 mi (3.4 km)
Elev Gain	18 ft (5.5 m)
Elev Loss	130 ft (39.7 m)

Parking & Trail Entrance

Directions to Leonard Bridge Rd. Air Line State Park Crossing: Lebanon, CT

From the intersection of Route 87 and Route 66, follow Route 66 west for 0.9 miles. Turn left onto Pine St. Follow Pine St. which will become Leonard Bridge Rd. at the town line.

Parking: There is a parking area for 12 cars along the side of Leonard Bridge Rd.

Directions to Lebanon Rd (Route 207). and Air Line State Park Crossing: Hebron, CT

From the intersection of Leonard Bridge Rd. and Exeter Rd. (Route 207) follow Exeter Rd. west for 2.7 miles. Exeter Rd. becomes Lebanon Rd. at the town line.

Parking: There is parking area for 4-5 cars on either side of Lebanon Rd.

98.4% (10,870 ft) of trail is	Hard
