## Kingsley Road to Village Hill Road

Lebanon, CT • Linear Trail

There are no fees for visiting the trail

**Length** 0.9 mi (1.5 km)

**Elev Gain** 67.2 ft (20.49 m)

**Elev Loss** 3.5 ft (1.07 m)

### Trail Entrance & Parking

**Directions to Kingsley Rd. and South Lebanon Air Line State Park Crossing - Lebanon, CT:**

From Bridge St. and Pleasant St. follow Pleasant St. west for approximately 1.33 miles.

**Parking:** There is parking available for a few cars along Kingsley Rd. but no official parking area. **DO NOT BLOCK GATE.**

**Directions Village Hill Rd. and South Lebanon Air Line State Park Crossing - Lebanon, CT:**

Follow Kingsley Rd. south to Baker Hill Rd., turn left onto Cards Mill Rd., stay on Cards Mill Rd. to 59 Village Hill Rd.

**Parking:** There is parking for a few cars on the westerly side of Village Hill Rd.



### Grade

**Typical Grade** 1.5%

**3.5%** (170 ft) of trail is **4% to 8%**

**At West Side Gate at Village Hill Road**  
**0.2%** (12 ft) of trail is **8% to 10.6%**

**ADA Maximum Ramp Grade** 8.3%



### Cross Slope

**Typical Cross Slope** 2%

**Max. Cross Slope** 15.6%

**Approaching Village Hill Road Gate**  
**9.7%** (469 ft) of trail is **4% to 15.6%**



### Tread Width

**Typical** 91 in

**Minimum** 36 in



### Surface

**Surface Type** Stone Dust

**99.6%** (4824 ft) of trail is **Hard**

**0.4%** (19 ft) of trail is **Paved**



### Obstructions

**ACCESS GATE AT KINGSLEY ROAD** is locked and footpath is 36 in. at right of gate.

**ACCESS GATE AT VILLAGE HILL ROAD** is locked and footpath is 36 in. at left of gate.

**WARNING:** Trail conditions may have changed since June 2019 when this trail was assessed. Temporary obstacles were not mapped.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:**  
Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) were not measured.
