Trail Entrance & Parking

Directions to Potter Road Air Line Trail Crossing - Hampton, CT:

From Route 6 and Route 97 intersection, follow Route 6 west 1.4 miles, turn right onto Potter Rd. Large Parking is available on Potter Road 0.6 miles north of its intersection with Route 6 at Goodwin Conservation & Nature Center. Parking area is about 0.25 south from Air Line Trail.

Parking: There is no official parking for the trail, however, 2-4 cars can park along the road.

Directions to S. Brook Road Air Line Trail Crossing- Hampton, CT:

From Route 6 and Route 97 intersection, follow Route 6 east 2.1 miles to South Brook Rd. Follow South Brook Rd. for .2 miles,

Parking: Roadside parking isavailable for 1-2 cars on the right.
