# CT Air Line State Park

## Potter Road west to South Brook Road

Hampton, CT • Linear Trail - There are no fees for visiting the trail

**Length** 1.0 mi (1.6 km)

**Elev Gain** 17 ft (5.2 m)

**Elev Loss** 75.4 ft (23 m)

### Trail Entrance & Parking

#### Directions to Potter Road Air Line Trail Crossing - Hampton, CT:

From Route 6 and Route 97 intersection, follow Route 6 west 1.4 miles, turn right onto Potter Rd. Large Parking is available on Potter Road 0.6 miles north of its intersection with Route 6 at Goodwin Conservation & Nature Center. Parking area is about 0.25 south from Air Line Trail.

**Parking:** There is no official parking for the trail, however, 2-4 cars can park along the road.

#### Directions to S. Brook Road Air Line Trail Crossing- Hampton, CT:

From Route 6 and Route 97 intersection, follow Route 6 east 2.1 miles to South Brook Rd. Follow South Brook Rd. for .2 miles,

**Parking:** Roadside parking is available for 1-2 cars on the right.

DO NOT BLOCK GATES.



### Grade

**Typical Grade** 1.8%

2.4% (124.5 ft) of trail is 7% - 9.2%

**ADA Maximum Ramp Grade** 8.3%



### Surface

**Surface Type Aggregate/Gravel**

98.2% (5034 ft) of trail is **Firm**

1.2% (61 ft) of trail is **Paved**

0.6% (31 ft) of trail is **Wood**



### Cross Slope

**Typical Cross Slope** 1.8%

**Max. Cross Slope** 5% - 8.7%



### Obstructions

**ACCESS GATE AT S. BROOK ROAD is locked and footpath is narrow 26 in. at left side of east gate with a large rock across access and a 6 in. step/drop-off.**



### Tread Width

**Typical** 58 in

**Minimum** 26 in

**WARNING:** Trail conditions may have changed since May 2018 when this trail was assessed. Temporary obstacles were not mapped.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) were not measured.
