**Trail Entrance & Parking** 

Village Hill Rd. and South Lebanon Air Line State Park Crossing - Lebanon, CT:

Follow Kingsley Rd. south to Baker Hill Rd., turn left onto Cards Mill Rd., stay on Cards Mill Rd. to 59 Village Hill Rd.

**Parking:** There is parking for a few cars on the westerly side of Village Hill Rd. **DO NOT BLOCK GATE** 

Directions Cook Hill Rd. and Air Line State Park Crossing - Lebanon, CT: From Village Hill Rd. go north 0.8 Miles, turn left onto Cook Hill Rd., follow for 1.2 miles

**Parking:** There is parking available on either side of Cook Hill Rd. for 8 cars. **DO NOT BLOCK GATE**

#### **Obstructions**

ACCESS GATE AT VILLAGE HILL ROAD is locked and footpath is 48 in. at left of gate.

ACCESS GATE AT COOK HILL ROAD is locked and footpath is 36 in. at right of gate.

**WARNING:** Trail conditions may have changed since June 2019 when this trail was assessed. Temporary obstacles were not mapped.

#### **OBSTRUCTIONS:**

Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) were not measured.
