East Thompson Road to Sand Dam Road

Thompson CT • Linear Trail

There are no fees for visiting the trail



Length 0.6 mi (1.0 km)

Elev Gain 57.6 ft (17.55 m)

Elev Loss 3.5 ft (1.06 m)

Parking & Trail Entrance

Directions to East Thompson Rd. Air Line Trail crossing: Thompson, CT

From Route 395 (Exit 50) and Route 200, go east on Thompson Hill Road (Route 200) 0.7 miles to Route 193. Turn left onto Route 193 and follow for 1.57 miles. At multiple road intersection, bear right onto East Thompson Road. Follow East Thompson Road for 3.3 miles past Speedway and golf course to parking on left at trail crossing just past junction with New Road.

Parking: There is a parking area for 15 – 20 cars.

Directions to Sand Dam Rd. Air Line Trail crossing: Thompson, CT

From Route 395 (Exit 50) and Route 200 go east on Thompson Hill Road (Route 200) 0.7 miles to Route 193. Turn left on Route 193 and follow for 1.57 miles. At multiple road intersection, bear right onto East Thompson Road. Follow East Thompson Road for 2.4 miles past Speedway and golf course. Turn left onto Sand Dam Rd. and follow for 0.2 miles to trail crossing.

Parking: There is parking on left side of road for 3-4 cars, but no official parking area.

Typical Grade 1.8%

1% (31 ft) of trail is 8.3% to 10.9%

4.2% (141 ft) of trail is 5.1% to 7.9%

Obstructions

Max Grade of 10.9% is near East Thompson Road gate.

Max Slope of 7.9% near East Thompson Road gate

ACCESS GATE at East Thompson Road footpath is narrow (26 in.)

WARNING: Trail conditions may have changed since July 2020 when this trail was assessed. Temporary obstacles were not mapped.

OBSTRUCTIONS:

Obstructions less than 2 in (5 cm) were not measured.
