# Hop River State Park Hop River Road to Parker Bridge Road

Coventry, CT • Linear Trail - There are no fees for visiting the trail

**Length** 1.4 mi (2.2 km)

**Elev Gain** 74.7 ft (22.78 m)

**Elev Loss** 8.7 ft (2.64 m)

### Parking & Trail Entrance

**Directions to Hop River Road Trailhead – Coventry, CT:** From Willimantic Rd. (Route 6) and Hop River Rd., take Hop River Rd. 0.4 miles to Air Line State Park Trail.

**Parking:** There is a parking area for 8 – 10 cars on the westerly side of Hop River Rd.

### Directions to Parker Bridge Road – Coventry, CT

From Willimantic Rd. (Route 6), take Parker Bridge Rd for 0.4 miles to Air Line State Park.

**Parking:** No official parking. There are 2-3 parking areas on side of road. Do not block gate entrance.



### Grade

**Typical Grade** 1.2%

0.7% (51ft) of trail is 6.3% to 8.4%

*ADA Maximum Ramp Grade* 8.3%



### Cross Slope

**Typical Cross Slope** 2.5%

9.3% (661 ft.) of trail is 5% -7.7%  
At various spots throughout the trail



### Tread Width

**Typical** 97 in

**Minimum** 32 in  
At Access Gate at Parker Bridge Road



### Surface

**Surface Type** Stone Dust

96% (6839 ft) of trail is Firm

3% (221 ft) of trail is Hard

1% (78 ft) of trail is Paved



### Obstructions

At bridge over the river, there is a 3" step.

**ACCESS GATE** at Parker Bridge Rd. is 32 in. around the gate.

**WARNING:** Trail conditions may have changed since October 2020 when this trail was assessed. Temporary obstacles were not mapped.

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
