## Old Growth Trail Leadmine Mountain Conservation Lands

Sturbridge, MA • Lollipop Trail • There are no fees for visiting the trail

Length	<b>0.2</b> mi <b>529</b> ft (0.3 km)
<b>Elev</b> Gain	<b>13.7</b> ft (4.8 m)
Elev Loss	<b>15.1</b> ft (4.6 m)

**Trail Details:** 529 ft, ST-1, ADA compliant. Trail color blue with black dot is a short, 529 foot, accessible loop trail off of the Arbutus Park Trail, 200 feet from the 10 OSV trail head. This is an ADA accessible trail, on an island created by Hamant Brook, that has not been logged for more than 150 years. The landscape reflects the tornado damage of 2011 as well as an old growth forest from the 1700s. The trail is suitable for wheelchairs. Some of the large pines in this area were toppled by the 2011 tornado that passed just to the north.

**Directions:** From the Rt. 20 and Stallion Hill Rd. traffic light, turn onto Stallion Hill Rd., take your 2nd left (100 ft) onto Old Sturbridge Village Rd. Follow for 1 mile to Lead Mine Trail Parking Lot on the right. Trailhead is close to exit 5 on Route 84 in Sturbridge.
