

**Show your love for The Last Green Valley** by organizing a Land or River Cleanup, Pollinator Garden Planting or Invasive Eradication Event.

The Last Green Valley, Inc. (TLGV) will **reimburse** your non-profit organization, municipal, regional, state or federal agency working in the National Heritage Corridor **up to \$500** for expenses like publicity, cleanup supplies (e.g. trash bags, work gloves, small gardening tools, etc.), native seeds and plantings, food for your volunteers and more. Projects outside the National Heritage Corridor, but within Thames River watershed towns, may be reimbursed up to \$250.

**To apply** submit a letter to Cassidy@tlgv.org on your organization's letterhead at **least four weeks before** the proposed event with the following information:

- Your contact information: phone number, address and email
- Basic details: who, what, where, when and why
- A budget detailing how the event will use TLGV funds
- How will you dispose of the trash
- How will you involve youth future stewards of The Last Green Valley
- How will the event and results be publicized
- For non-profit organizations: submit a copy of your 501(c)

TLGV reserves the right to approve or deny funds based upon the likelihood of project success and availability of funds. If TLGV approves funding, you will need to sign a short agreement and you must promise to acknowledge TLGV's funding in your publicity materials.

You must complete and return the TLGV "Trash Tracker" forms for cleanups and provide a complete Volunteer List after the event to receive your funds.
